"But on the first day of the week, at early dawn, they came to the tomb, taking the spices that they had prepared. They found the stone rolled away from the tomb, but when they went in, they did not find the body. While they were perplexed about this, suddenly two men in dazzling clothes stood beside them. The women were terrified and bowed their faces to the ground, but the men said to them, "Why do you look for the living among the dead? He is not here but has risen."

Here, in the depths of the Lenten Season, we start looking for the glories of Easter morning. Your pastors, worship planners and choirs are letting the "Alleluias" seep out a little early. The planning is well underway, the music is selected, and the celebration is laid out. Yet, here we still are, in the depths of the Lenten Season, in the solitude of the road to the cross, in the purple-ness of the journey.

Rainbows appear after the rains, and the sun peaks through the storm clouds. Life is not all a Lenten journey... or is it?

"Why do you look for the living among the dead?" We look for the living among the dead because Christ has given us life. We look for the living among the dead because the author of life dwells within us. We look for the living because Christ has promised us life. We look for, and forward to, life. So, whether we are tending to the sick, or grieving, or celebrating a newborn, we look for life. We look for the Living One, the giver of life. And, in all of our looking, He is looking back at us. He is looking at you, celebrating you and your life here, and your life in the world to come. He is the source of life for all the living. He rejoices over your now. He rejoices also, over your life to come.





The book includes Pastor Engebretson's personal stories, hymns, and illustrations, making it an excellent read. He served at St. John's from 1994-2000.




